2) Interview

Upon receipt of the application packet, the athletic office will contact you within 3-5 business days to decline your application or schedule your interview with an athletic administrator. The athlete and at least one parent must attend the interview.

Within 24 hours of the completed interview, you will be contacted to either proceed to the next step of the enrollment checklist or to be informed that we will not continue the process of enrolling your athlete in SCA Athletics. SCA reserves the right to accept or deny admission based on the information provided in the completed application packet and interview.

FHSAA documentation, as required by the state of Florida, must be submitted before tryouts.

5) Enrollment Fee

Upon being placed on a team, the fee for that sport and its player pack (up to \$100) must be paid within 15 days of the acceptance date (**cash/check only**). Fees per sport:

He or she may be indefinitely expelled. 6. Any student known to deface or destroy school property will be assessed the full cost of repairs and be subject possible disciplinary action, including dismissal from the team. It is the sole responsibility of the parent to provide the athletic office with updated records and legal documents (including custody arrangements). 8.
